

# NEWTON AND BYWELL PHOTO COMPETITION 2021

## Terms and Conditions of entry

### Newton and Bywell through the seasons

It is up to you how you interpret it but we're looking for stunning photographs of the landscape, local wildlife, village life, agriculture or recreation.

This year our first competition will be virtual, and there will be two deadlines. Entries must be received before:

1st August

1st December

Entries can be submitted any time up to the last day of the month. The top ten photos will be published in the subsequent Newsletter.

1. The theme is open to individual interpretation, but entries must be taken within the parish boundaries of Newton and Bywell.
2. The competition is open only to residents living within Bywell Parish. There will be two categories (i) aged 15 and under and (ii) aged 16 and over. The winner in each category will receive a prize of £25.
3. Entrants under the age of 18 will need to include the name, address, contact telephone and email address of their parent or guardian, and the parent or guardian will need to give written consent for their child to take part.
4. To submit your photo(s), please email as attachments to [info@newtonandbywell.org](mailto:info@newtonandbywell.org)  
You can enter up to three separate photos for each category. These can be any format (portrait, square, landscape) but should be as high a resolution as possible. If offered a choice when emailing (Small, Medium, Large or Actual Size) please select 'Actual Size'.
5. Each entry should be marked with the following: name, full postal address, email address, age category and where the photo was taken.
6. Images may be digitally enhanced to remove spots or scratches, but not manipulated. Entrants can enhance the picture to make it brighter, clearer etc, but not manipulate the content. All entries must be the original work of the entrant.
7. Finalists and winners will be chosen by a group of judges selected by the Hall Trustees.
8. Entrants must not be professional photographers, and, for the purposes of this competition, a professional photographer will be

considered to be someone who makes more than half their annual income from the sale of their photographs.

9. Images may be used for possible inclusion in press releases promoting the amenities of Newton and Bywell, and to provide a record of competition winners on the Newton and Bywell website or other media.
10. Copyright of each image will remain the property of the author.

By submitting an entry you are confirming the following:

- That the photographs were taken by yourself (or state the name and age if you are submitting them for someone under 16)
- Your permission for the images (or image owner) to be used in any associated publicity, including the village web site, Newsletter and Facebook page (if you don't want your picture on the internet please let us know, or we can arrange for it to appear as low resolution only)
- That the parents/guardians of any children in the pictures have given permission for the inclusion of their images
- You understand that by entering this competition, you are agreeing to all the terms and conditions stated above
